

Global Amateur Radio Emergency Communication The 2013 Conference in Zurich / Switzerland

Do we really need Amateur Radio Emergency Communication in the middle of Europe? We often hear this question when speaking with government delegations or authorities. Most of them believe that in the "1st World" the infrastructure is so good and technical level so high that a disaster could not affect a wide area. Maybe they are correct in one point: the topography in central Europe is special, and the infrastructure is built to maintain a high level of security. A disaster affecting a large area would be very rare in this part of Europe. Even in the event of an earthquake, individual sections might be manageable; only a blackout over a long period of time could be considered a disaster with a large affected area. As a result, we need other systems of emergency communication in this part of the world. Often we require a local area emergency network for our communication. We also need communication with high data transfer rates to unaffected parts of the country.

How do we accomplish this, and which technical solutions are possible? These are aspects we will discuss with you next June in Zurich. We will also show you the opportunities provided by HAMNET in Amateur Radio Emergency Communication. GAREC 2013 will be combined with our biennial national EmComm-meeting "Swiss Convention of Amateur Radio Emergency Communication" (June 27). We thus invite you to travel to Switzerland and enjoy GAREC 2013 with us.

How to obtain an Amateur Radio Guest License in Switzerland

This information may be helpful when you plan to make amateur radio operation during your stay in Switzerland. In some cases you have to apply for a guest license. If your country is a CEPT country or if it is listed in TR61/01 then you can make amateur radio operation with your regular license without doing any paperwork.

CEPT Country

Check in the downloadable file "TR6101.PDF0.pdf" whether your country is listed as CEPT country (page 5 and 6). If you see your license in row 3 then you can make amateur radio in Switzerland. Your call sign will be HB9/YOURCALL

ANNEX 4: Equivalence

When you can find your country listed in the downloadable file "TR6101.PDF0.pdf" on page 8 to 10, you can proceed as it would be a CEPT country.

Other Countries

Only if your license is from another country you have to apply for a guest license. To do so send to the Federal Office of Communications OFCOM (BAKOM) e-mail or a letter with the following:

- Filled form "Application for a temporary amateur radio license"
- Photocopy of your amateur radio license
- Photocopy of your passport or ID
- When available a photocopy of qualifications held.
- Check, postgiro receipt or any other proof of payment
- → Proceed time: Your documents have to be at BAKOM at least 30 days ahead.
- → Costs: The price for the guest license is 80.00 CHF for one month, 90.00 CHF for two months or 100.00 CHF for 3 months.
- → How to pay: The downloadable file "Options for payments from outside Switzerland"
